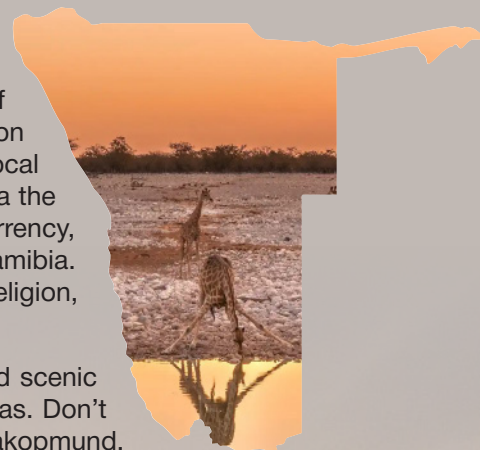

## About Namibia

Namibia, located in southern Africa, is a stunning destination with a mix of urban culture and breathtaking natural beauty. It has a population of 3 million people from diverse cultures. The official language is English with 11 local languages widely spoken. The capital city, Windhoek, is easily accessible via the Hosea Kutako International Airport. The Namibian Dollar (NAD) is the local currency, although the South Africa Rand (ZAR) is also accepted as legal tender in Namibia. Both currencies are pegged at a 1:1 ratio. Christianity is the predominant religion, with around 90% of the population identifying as Christian.

Namibia is a safe and welcoming country, with excellent infrastructures and scenic roads (ranked 51 globally). Tap water is generally safe to drink in urban areas. Don't miss the must-see attractions: Etosha National Park, Sossusvlei Dunes, Swakopmund, and the Skeleton Coast.



### Climate



Namibia has mostly a subtropical desert climate with the rainy season occurring between November to April. The summer months can become hot with temperatures hitting 35°C or higher in the north and south. Winter months (May-Sept) are pleasant although temperatures can drop below zero.



### Getting Around

Domestic flights are available. Roads are well maintained and car hire is readily available, coaches and busses run to and from the major cities within Namibia.
